Game time is an opportunity to have fun and play around the AWANA Game Square and enjoy athletic competition as they learn Christ-like sportsmanship. These are the means by which AWANA provides children the opportunity to hear the good news of Jesus Christ, study and memorize the Bible, and grow in their faith in Jesus Christ.

### **AWANA CLUB RULES** First Baptist Church of Rockville

#### Drop-off & Pick-up

1. All children must be toilet-trained to participate in AWANA clubs.

2. Please do not bring a child who appears to be ill or has been ill within the last 24 hours with fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or anything that may be contagious to another child.

3. Please bring your child(ren) to the check-in Desk by 4:45pm. Our club workers will be available by 4:45pm so please do not leave your child(ren) unattended until the club leaders arrive. We begin Opening Ceremony at <u>5:00pm SHARP</u>.

4. AWANA clubs dismiss at 7:00pm. Please come inside to pick up your child as we will <u>NOT</u> dismiss children to a parent or designated adult until check-out procedure is completed. Please make arrangements with the Commander, Club Director or Registration team prior to club as to who will pick up your child. Your child's safety is of extreme importance to us.

#### **Respect**

1. Respect other clubbers, leaders, directors, and all those who are in a leadership position.

2. Respectful language, behavior, and dress are always expected. Pushing, shoving and rough-housing are not allowed during club time.

3. Care and respect for church property & other people's belongings must be demonstrated at all times.

#### **Discipline**

- 1. We use a "5 count" for group discipline and a "3 count" count for individuals who do not follow club behavior standards.
- 2. Running is allowed only on the Game Square during game time. No running in the hallways or classrooms.
- 3. Parents will be notified if a child will be suspended from club for repeated disruptive behavior.

#### **Uniform/Dress Code**

1. Tennis shoes or sneakers **must** be worn to participate in Game time.

2. Upon receiving the uniform, the clubber should wear it to every regular AWANA club night. Awards are presented only to clubbers who are wearing uniforms.

3. Girls should wear pants, jeans or shorts during Game time.

#### Handbook and Game Time

1. All AWANA clubbers must bring Handbook and Bible to each AWANA night.

2. Handbook sections must be passed by clubbers in one session. A maximum of two helps per section is allowed.

3. At least one handbook or lesson section must be passed or completed in every club night. Clubbers who do not pass a handbook section for 3 consecutive club nights may not be rewarded or allowed to participate in the AWANA store night.

4. During game time, there is always the possibility that a child will injure themselves. A complete liability release form is required for all children. Please know that we will protect & care for your child to the best of our ability. We have trained leaders in First Aid & CPR.

#### **Attendance**

AWANA clubbers are encouraged to regularly attend club and Sunday school in their church. To receive club attendance awards, attendance must comply with the AWANA club standards; no more than one un-excused club absence per 8-week period.
Clubbers earn the privilege to shop at the AWANA store to spend their bucks earned throughout the club year.

**NOTE**: All new clubbers will need to purchase a book; returning clubbers who did not finish their book last year can begin by finishing that book, but will need to purchase the next book upon completion of their old book. New clubbers will need to purchase a new uniform, as will returning clubbers going into a new club (EX: 3rd grader who was a Spark (2<sup>nd</sup> grade) last year going into T&T this year needs a T&T uniform). It is recommended that parents pay in advance. **However, be advised that** *the uniform and book must be earned by the clubber. To earn their book & uniform, clubbers must complete their entrance booklet.* AWANA does not issue refunds. Therefore, if a book and/or uniform is paid for in advance, yet the clubber(s) fails to earn his/her book and/or uniform in the course of the AWANA club year, those funds will not be refunded.
