

WHAT TO EXPECT AS YOU COME BACK TO CHURCH:

Temperature Monitoring at Front Entrance

Volunteers will check your temperature with contactless thermometers before you enter our facilities. If you are showing signs of a fever (100.4° F or higher), you will be asked to worship online.

Face Masks are Required

For the safety of everyone, we are requiring that everyone (over age 2) who attends worship wear a face mask. You may bring your own, or we will have some provided.

Hand Sanitizers Provided

Although not recommended to replace good handwashing, we will be providing hand sanitizer for your use. There are two stationary, automatic dispensers – in the Foyer near the entrance out in the hallway for use. There are also hand-pump hand sanitizers in many places throughout the building for your use including hallway by the fellowship hall.

Our goal is to provide a Touchless Environment

In our effort to provide a touchless environment, doors will be propped open and we have removed as much touchable items as possible. This includes the space area the kids will be doing their Sunday programs. Hand sanitizers and tissues or paper towels are available where touching is unavoidable (i.e. bathrooms). **Kids will be strongly encouraged to wash their hands prior to entering the Children's ministry area.**

Practice Social Distancing

Please remember to maintain a safe physical distance of at least 6-7 feet apart. Seating has been arranged in the Sanctuary for safe distancing. Family groups may sit together, please remain in your own area during worship. We will dismiss as directed following services to avoid crowded

hallways. Our Foyer area cannot be a spot to hang out and chat, please use the parking lot for that. While we cannot hug or shake hands, it's ok to smile and wave! Or give air high-fives!

Nursery Childcare will Not be Available

We will not have childcare in the Nursery but infants will be welcomed in worship and seen as a blessing, not a distraction. Children who want to stay in the sanctuary will sit with their families during worship. Preschool & Elementary age children will be in the fellowship hall areas.

Amenities: Coffee, Bulletins, and Prayer Lists

We have suspended the coffee service in the Coffee Area and all water fountains are covered and out of use to reduce commonly touched surfaces and the spread of germs. Please do not bring any food or drinks into the building. The sermon notes are available on our website! Monthly Communion elements will be distributed in individual servings as a prepackaged all-in-one wafer and juice cup at the end of services as your family goes out of the building.

Offering Collection

An offering will not be taken by passing the plate; instead, we will leave the plates at the Sanctuary exits for individuals to drop their tithes and offerings. Online giving is also still an option!

Cleaning, Disinfecting, and Sanitizing

The campus is on a regular cleaning and sanitization schedule during the week to prepare spaces before and after their next use. Volunteers and children's ministry team members will be disinfecting chairs, sanitizing contact surfaces and cleaning before and after service.

Drop-off & Pick-up of Children

Families will check at the front of the church entrance and from there have the option to stay together in the service or let volunteers and youth to take kids to Children's ministry areas in Fellowship Hall. After service kids will be brought up to the front of the foyer for parents to pick up as they make their way out of the building.

If in Doubt or Immunocompromised – Please continue to Worship Online

We are all in this together. People who feel sick should worship online. Contact and follow the advice of your medical provider. If you are immunocompromised, you may want to continue to worship online for now. We miss you all, but our goal is to make sure everyone stays healthy and safe!
